You have visited Rittenhouse and have documented your observations of this urban space through drawings, and viewfinder sketches.

Part 1:

Review the drawings you have made of Rittenhouse thus far. Look for the following in those drawings:

- **Geometry**
- **Axis**
- **Frame**
- **Layer** (foreground, middle ground, background)

If you cannot find these terms illustrated in your current drawings, revisit the park and look specifically for these organizational principles when completing new drawings.

Part 2:

For your first Illustrated Dictionary assignment, draw examples found at Rittenhouse that illustrate the four principles listed above in both plan and in viewfinder vignette.

To complete this assignment, you must redraw previously completed drawings on new pages in the sketchbook or make new drawings that clearly illustrate the terms.

Draw with intent, focusing on the terminology you are illustrating as well as craft and composition of the overall page.

- A total of 8 illustrations are required (1 plan & 1 viewfinder drawing per word).
- Use one sketchbook page per illustrated word (for a total of four pages with two illustrations per page).
- Write the word on the top of the page as well as the date for each illustration you make.
- Provide a caption that briefly describes the content of the illustrations.
